

Scholarship Descriptions for

- **Cardinal Brennan High School graduates who graduated in 2007 and earlier years**
- **Graduates of any Catholic High School who graduated in 2008, or later, and reside in the geographic area served by the following school districts at the time of their graduation from a Catholic High School:**
 - **North Schuylkill School District**
 - **Shenandoah Valley School District**
 - **Mahanoy Area School District**

Dr. Rudolph A. Constien Scholarship Fund

Funds are available for the education of persons who are bona fide residents of the Borough of Ashland at the time of filing this application. Grants are made to help individuals attend college and universities, attend graduate schools, complete periods of advanced training, or begin training for a nursing career.

Carr-Willower Memorial Scholarship

Provides scholarships to graduates of Cardinal Brennan High School (see criteria listed above) for their attendance at any accredited college or university, and this shall include funding for graduate work. Preference shall be given to graduates who plan to enroll, or are enrolled in a program leading to a Bachelor, master and/or Doctor degree in education, and/or educational administration. Although preference shall be given to this group, this shall not constitute a limitation, and grants may be made to graduates not in this group.

Mary I. Kull Memorial Scholarship

Funds are available for the education of persons who are bona fide residents of the Borough of Ashland at the time of filing this application. Grants are made to help individuals attend colleges and universities, attend graduate schools, complete periods of advanced training for a nursing career or to educate or care for handicapped persons.

Dr. Robert Douglas Spencer Memorial Fund

Provides scholarships to graduates of Cardinal Brennan High School (see criteria listed above) who are furthering their education or training at a college or university, graduate school, training for a nursing career, or attending eligible trade and craft schools. Preference will be given for the education and training of medical students, medical technicians, nurses and hospital administrators.

Provides scholarship assistance for education above the high school level to children, step-children and adopted children and to grandchildren, step-grandchildren and adopted grandchildren of members and retired members, as of April 30, 1998, of the United Steel Workers of America, Local No. 14372.
